10 CRITICAL STEPS YOU NEED TO TAKE PRE-DIVORCE

- 1. **Breathe.** Enroll in yoga classes to help keep you calm and your mind clear. Do not make any impulse decisions that could cause you to make big money mistakes.
- 2. **Hire a CERTIFIED FINANCIAL PLANNER™** Pre-Divorce. Some Financial Planners hold the Certified Divorce Financial Analyst™ designation or they partner with one. This is the type of planner you want on your team.
- 3. **Hire a team.** Your team may include a CERTIFIED FINANCIAL PLANNERTM, Certified Divorce Financial AnalystTM, Divorce Attorney, Banker, Tax Advisor, Insurance Agent, Estate Planning Attorney, Certified Public Accountant, Certified Valuation Analyst and Therapist.
- 4. If possible, **keep an amicable relationship with your soon to be ex-spouse.**Determine how you will communicate with each other, your family, and your children. Communication that you can refer back to is preferable.
- 5. **Focus on getting your divorce** resolved through mediation. Mediation is typically desired, but you should still have a trusted lawyer to confide in and ask important questions.
- 6. **Get organized**, make sure you have the most important documents in one place and readily accessible. I cannot stress this enough. You need to be ready to present any material that is legally requested.
